

Students Satisfaction Survey Report, 2019-20

The student satisfaction survey forms as per NAAC guidelines were distributed reading in +3 1st year 2nd year and 3rd year classes of Arts, Science and Commerce stream. 100 numbers of forms distributed to students during the month of December 2019 and January 2020. The filled forms are collected from the students and analysis to record the following finding and the majority opinion are given below

1. Completion of Course

90% of the students reported that teachers covered 85-100% of course. But 10% of students tag it to 65-70%.

2. Lesson planning

Regarding the lesson planning, 75% of students feel that teachers lesson plan is thorough and appropriate to achieve the goal but 25% of the student feel that it is satisfactory

3. Teachers closeness of the students.

In this regard 95% of the students opined that teachers maintain the close relationship but 5% of students feel th. at teachers are not close to them

4. Internal evaluation.

In this regard 100% of the students stated that teachers provide timely feedback to their performance in internal examination

5. Course outcome

Students satisfaction shows that 70% of the students are satisfied with the course and programme outcome but 30% of the students are poor on the course and programme outcome needs improvement

6. Learners centric approach

In this regard 75% of the students are satisfied but 25% of the students are lagging behind

7. Use of soft skills, life skill and employability

80% of the student suggest that they are assisted in this regard to a great extent but less than 20% of the students are moderate type

8. Use of ICT tools and projector

About 75% of the student are comfortable using ICT tools and others are lagging behind

9. Overall quality and standard of teaching

90% of the student are strongly agree that quality and teaching methods are praiseworthy but 10% of the students are poorly satisfied.
